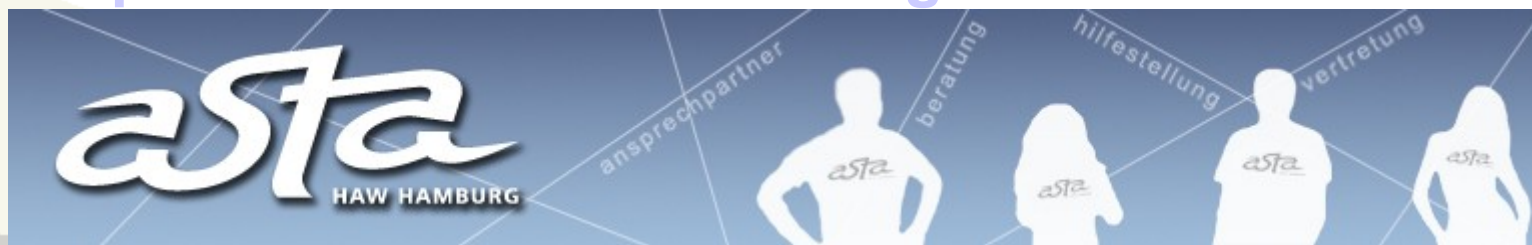
Student life

- **Cost of a student life**

The rents of a student residence is between 170€ ~ 300€. All bills are included. Internet access is however individual to each residence. Most of the public transport fees are paid already as you register as a student. The food and drinks are more or less the same price as in France. It's also easy to find student discounts for trains, cinemas and concerts.

- **Orientation**

In the first week, there is always an orientation team who will show you our facilities in the university and some instructions of your schedule of exams or holidays.

- **Tutor**

Normally, our ECS professor is your tutor in the univ. there is not personal tutor in your accommodation but there is an administrator in all the residences who taking care the condition of your room.

- **Languages**

It's common that the student can speak either German or English or French. As Hamburg is an international city, there are a lot of people from different countries and different culture background.

How to enroll?

- Main required documents
every student in hamburg must provide a sufficient health insurance to student centre.
After you settle down in your room, should go to the nearest cityhall to register your address.
After all the paper work is done, you will receive your student ID card from **Studentenzentrum: student centre.**
- Enrollment time
The first whole month of the start of each semester is the time for enrollment. After this period, there would be a extract charge for late enroll.
